### "What We Are Busy About"

Man, are we busy! But, it is not enough to be busy, so are the ants. The question is: "What are we busy about?" One author said: "Happiness is often the result of being too busy to be miserable." This might not always be the case although this has been accurate with the Carney Clan since we rang in the new year! So what are we busy about, you ask? Thanks for asking...

Solar living means that daily we maintain the levels of our batteries, turn the solar pump on and off, run the generator, and do a flurry of activity that requires electricity when the sun is high & hot. But in ministry, we are busy about this weekly routine...

**HOME SCHOOLING**—This is Elisabeth's ministry and she dedicates hours to the education of T-n-T.

**LESSONS**—I prepare 5 different lessons per week—1 for our Tuesday night Bible study, 3 for the boy's home and 1 for the orphanage on Saturday.

**TRAINING**—I write materials for the training of the national pastors in Guatemala. I am returning to teach several pastors in a few weeks.

**CHURCH PLANT**—I drive 4 hours round trip to Tadzibichen every Thursday with Luis (national pastor) and my father to share the gospel and follow up on the contacts that we are making.

**CYCLING**—From spinning while discussing theology, to sharing the gospel card over a cup of coffee, to promoting good books to read (e.g. More than a Carpenter & Developing the Leader Within You), or handing out a Gideon's NT, the opportunities are literally endless.

Would you pray that in our business that we would be short with sin, deep with integrity, and wide with legacy and fruitfulness?
